Subject: Amendment - Alternate Formula - Add Mole Crickets to Labeling
 B & G Diazinon 5G
 EPA Registration No. 6720-35
 Your Letters Dated June 27, August 12,
 and November 26, 1988

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Under the Directions for Use, add an application rate to the section on "Mole Crickets."
2. Update the label Storage and Disposal statement per PR Notices 83-3 and 84-1.
3. Update the Environmental Hazards section by changing "Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or by disposal of waste." to "... water when disposing of equipment washwaters."
4. In the Statement of Practical Treatment, under If Swallowed, insert "Repeat until vomit fluid is clear." after "Drink one or two glasses of water..."
5. Revise the Note to Physician as follows:

Note to Physician: Diazinon is an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine.

6. The alternate formulas submitted on June 27 and November 28, 1988 are acceptable; however, we have the following comments regarding the confidential statement of formula:

a. Based on the current Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated September 16, 1987, your product will not meet the label claim for the active ingredient. Note that the lower limit of the active must be the same as the label claim in pure active form. Please revise the label or the CSF so the information agrees.

b. Although your cover letter of June 27, 1988 indicates that you have submitted an alternate formulation, the CSF dated September 16, 1987 submitted with that letter is marked "basic formulation." We assume you mean alternate and have corrected the CSF accordingly.

Note that the reregistration standard for products containing diazinon was issued in December 1988 and amended August 1989. Since this product contains diazinon, you should assure yourself that you are in compliance with data requirements and label changes requested under this registration standard.

Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.
