**CHINCH BUGS AND SOD WEBWORMS IN ORNAMENTAL TURF:** Apply as a broadcast application at the rate of 5 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. or 215 lbs. per acre. Water after application. (Use setting #5 on Model B Cyclone Spreader.)

**WARNING:** Keep children and pets off treated areas until this material is washed into the soil and grass is dry.
