## NOTICE

## DANGER IN USING

Sodium Arsenite is poisonous therefore, precaution must be observed when handling. (See antidote and warnings below.)

Store the solution in a safe place. Children must not be able to reach or handle the solution. It is recommended that only the amount of diluted solution be prepared from the concentrate that will be used immediately.

Mix the solution into water outdoors or in a well ventilated room. Wash off the outside of the bottle of solution in running water before storing away.

Avoid spray drift to desirable plants.

Animals must not be able to reach the solution.

This product is toxic to wildlife. Birds and other wildlife in treated areas may be killed.

DO NOT contaminate water used for irrigation or domestic purposes.

DO NOT apply where runoff is likely to occur. DO NOT contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes.

DO NOT contaminate feed, water or food stuffs.

DO NOT apply to areas underlaid by roots of desirable trees and shrubs.

## DANGER

SODIUM ARSENITE is poisonous if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin or eyes. DO NOT get on skin or eyes. DO NOT breathe fumes. Avoid prolonged exposure to fumes. Wear natural rubber gloves, protective clothing and goggles when handling the solution.

Avoid getting the solution on painted surfaces as peeling of paint will occur. Rinse spray hoses thoroughly after use, as Sodium Arsenite will deteriorate hose materials. Wash application equipment thoroughly with water after use. Dispose of Sodium Arsenite rinse or wash water so that it cannot contaminate soil or directly or indirectly come in contact with persons or animals. When container is empty, immediately wash and destroy. Never re-use.

In case of contact, wash immediately with soap and water. Wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and water before eating or smoking. Wash all contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before re-use.

## ANTIDOTE

Call a physician immediately in cases of suspected poisoning.

**INTERNAL** — If any of the solution is swallowed, give a tablespoonful of salt in a glass of warm water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Then give 2 tablespoonfuls of Epsom Salt or Milk of Magnesia in water, and plenty of milk and water. Have victim lie down and keep quiet.

**EXTERNAL** — If the material has been spilled on the skin, immediately remove patient from the vicinity of the solution, remove all contaminated clothing, and wash skin with soap and running water. If the material gets into the eyes, wash immediately with running water for at least ten minutes.
