

COCKROACH CONTROL

RESISTANT AND NON-RESISTANT COCKROACHES

Dilute the required amount of D/V 217 in water. Mix according to the following table to obtain the desired concentration of 0.25% or 0.50% D/V 217 insecticide. Use higher concentration (0.50%) on severe infestations and the lower concentration (0.25%) on light infestations.

FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS

FOOD AREAS APPLICATION LIMITED TO CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY - Includes areas for receiving, storage, packing, handling, bottling, wrapping, boxing, preparing and for warehousing of food and food systems (mills, canneries, edible oils, syrups). Serving areas (where food is exposed and facility is open to the public) are not included in this area.

Use 1/2% spray and apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using a spray nozzle capable of delivering a pin stream of insecticide in points between different elements of construction, between pipes and conduits, under baseboards, where cockroaches hide. **Do not** use this product on fans, motor housings, and electrical switch boxes.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the insecticide on food or food processing surfaces.

Apply in a manner that will not contaminate food or food handling areas. Dishes and food handling utensils should be thoroughly washed and sanitized before use. Repeat treatment as needed.

NOTE: A period of 4 to 7 days after treatment is required for the product to take effect on cockroaches.

For the purpose of this study, a total of 1000 participants were recruited from the general population of the United Kingdom.
