Dear Mr. McLane:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Add a footnote to the statement of ingredients:

Contains petroleum distillates.

2. The directions for use section must begin with the restriction, "To be used in non-food areas only." (This should immediately follow "It is a violation of federal law...")

3. In the section, "Meat Packing and Food Processing Plants," in the second paragraph, after the sentence, "Repeat application, if necessary, when plant is not in operation," add the sentence, "Do not use in food areas."

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

The revised Confidential Statement of Formula, dated September 10, 1992 is acceptable and has been included in our file for the product.

Although this product apparently was accepted for use in meat packing plants, we have no authorization by the US Department of Agriculture in our files. Please submit the appropriate authorization issued by USDA. We would like to have your reply within 75 days. Note that you may have to submit a copy of your current label for review by USDA and that they may require modifications in the part of the label that applies to use in federally inspected packing plants.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Plastic - Triple rinse (or equivalent). DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in manner inconsistent with its labeling. Apply with a low pressure sprayer equipped with a coarse spray nozzle. Spray surfaces only until wet. Avoid excessive run-off. Apply to cockroach breeding sites and harborage. Also, treat adjacent exposed surfaces where cockroaches may crawl when they come out of hiding. Repeat treatment as necessary. Cockroaches are normally found in dark corners of rooms and closets, at base of walls, in cracks in the wall, behind baseboards, behind and beneath sinks, refrigerators, stoves, and cabinets, around drain pipes, in and around water containers, floor drains and switch panels. Dishes and food handling utensils should be thoroughly washed in soap and water if they become contaminated by the application of this product. Repeat treatment as needed.
