**DIRECTIONS**

Lawns, Golf Courses and Ornamental Turf (other than pasture land) — for the control of Mole Crickets apply at the rate of 150 pounds per acre (3½ pounds per 1000 sq. ft.). Scatter evenly over the area to be treated. Use a suitable mechanical spreader.

Make application in late afternoon.

**USE PRECAUTIONS**

Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed. This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Fish may be killed if their water is contaminated with this product. Keep out of any body of water. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

Keep children and pets off treated areas until material is washed into soil and grass is dry.

**CAUTION**
