Wasps: Application should be made in the late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

CAUTION

Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Use in food processing plants only when the plant is not in operation. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. Room should be ventilated for 2 hours after spraying. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.
