HOW LAWN-GARD WORKS

LAWN-GARD SPRAY contains chlorpyrifos and dichlorvos (DDVP) insecticides and a wetting agent specially formulated for the control of Chinch Bugs, and Sod Webworms in deep thatch or dry conditions. This product combines the excellent kill qualities of chlorpyrifos with a wetting agent to insure deep penetration. The vapor action of DDVP acts as an irritant causing increased insect activity. LAWN-GARD SPRAY penetrates the thatch and drives the Chinch Bugs out.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Pests of Lawns and other Ornamental and Recreational Turf Grass Areas: Use LAWN-GARD SPRAY insecticide to control ants, brown dog ticks, chinch bugs, crickets, cutworms, earwigs, grasshoppers and sod webworms (lawn moths). Mix LAWN-GARD SPRAY with water according to directions given in the following table and apply as a coarse, low pressure spray using suitable application equipment. For best results, the lawn should be moist at time of treatment, and care should be taken to obtain complete and uniform coverage of pest infested areas. Spray when pests first appear, retreat when needed.
