# DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For most effective results against the active stages of flying, running and crawling insects, use in a good sprayer adjusted to deliver a fine mist.

Treat infested areas thoroughly and whenever possible, keep doors and windows closed for 10 minutes after spraying.

**FLYING INSECTS:** For control of flies, including fruit flies, mosquitoes, gnats, sand flies, wasps, hornets, direct the spray toward the upper portions of the room and saturate the atmosphere with the mist, using 1 to 2 ounces to each 1000 cubic feet of space. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat treatment as necessary.

**CRAWLING INSECTS:** To control roaches, silverfish, crickets and spiders, spray infested areas thoroughly and direct the liquid behind baseboards, moldings, cabinets, shelves, sinks, door and window frames and pipes, toward drains and dark corners, and into cracks, crevices, recesses.

Against ant infestations, treat shelves, cabinets and storage areas, spray ant run trails, baseboards, thresholds and other places of entry, and treat nests liberally.

In controlling fleas and Brown Dog ticks in the house, direct the application toward the lower wall portions, baseboards, runs, carpets and floors of infested areas. Animal quarters, kennels and bedding should also be sprayed.

To control bedbugs effectively, apply liberally to top, ends, sides and bottom of mattresses, spraying thoroughly all tufts, seams and folds. Spray springs and frame, directing the liquid into all cracks and joints. Treat walls, baseboards, moldings, floor, closets and bedroom furniture, picture frames, with particular attention to protected bedbug hiding and breeding places.

For most effective control of clothes moths and carpet beetles, remove infested article from storage, brush thoroughly and, if possible, air several hours in direct sunlight. Apply spray liberally in empty chest, closets, bureaus and storages, directing the liquid into cracks, joints and crevices. After airing, infested article may be treated by holding the spray nozzle at least 2 feet away from the fabric and applying the liquid lightly to the seams to avoid the possibility of staining. Repeat treatments monthly, unless the article are stored in moth tight containers.

For carpet beetles, the pest should be directly contacted with spray to obtain adequate control. For rug beetles, the sides of rug, under pad, and under pads, floor and surrounding areas. For upholstered furniture treat the interior as well as the exterior of the piece. Shelves, closets and area under furniture should be treated. Do not over spray, if product is made of rubber or plastic, it is rated to prevent expansion or swelling. Repeat treatments as necessary.

Kitchen and institutional pantries and food storages frequently become infested with confused flour beetle. Any time grain is brought into warehouse, it is often infested with sawtoothed grain beetle, Mediterranean flour moth, Indian meal moth, weevils, grain shippers, grain and cheese moths. To avoid source of reinfestation, wormy flour, grain and cheese should be properly treated. Spray thoroughly all surfaces of shelves, bins, cupboards, cabinets, pantry, cooler, and surrounding areas, with particular attention to cracks, niches and crevices.
