Tobacco moth, which is not a pest of stored grain, is also controlled by the granules. The granules are used in the crawling stages. In cracks and crevices of the storage, the granules are applied in a thin layer. The granules should be fumigated or treated by other effective means if the insects are in the egg or pupal stages.

The insecticidal components per kg of active ingredient are: cyfluthrin 0.6 g/l; deltamethrin 0.75 g/l; fenprophosphor 0.8 g/l; fenvalerate 0.9 g/l. The detected allowable residue level is $\Delta = 0.01 \text{ mg/kg}$.

For Treatment of Floors and Bins: Pyrethrin sprays of 1.0% concentration, applied to the surface of the grain, will control grain and feed insects for 1 month in the bin. For control of insects in grain, use 0.05% concentration, where in feed for. Apply 1.0% concentration to feed for 1 day, and 0.05% concentration to feed for 1 month. Repeat each 750 sq. ft. test of surface. Repeat every 10 days for 1 month.
