Use a suitable mechanical aproduction in and applications in late afternoon when it is not likely to rain.

NOTE: Mole Crickets are most active at night, especially after a rain or irrigation and when the temperature is above 70°F. When conditions such as these exist, the mole cricket will come to the surface and make burrows in the upper inch or two of soil. It is during this period that they emerge and gather bits of food (bait) from the soil surface.
