Human Hazards:

Keep out of reach of children. May be harmful if swallowed. Do not take internally. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Flush contaminated eyes with plenty of water and get medical attention if irritation persists. Wash contaminated clothing before re-use. DO NOT contaminate feed and foodstuffs.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Malathion is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine is an antidote.

Environmental Hazards:

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Fish may be killed if their water is contaminated. Keep out of any body of water. DO NOT apply where runoff is likely to occur. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product
in a manner inconsistent with its labeling

To control Mole Crickets infesting lawns, golf courses and ornamental turf. Apply at the rate of 2.0 lbs. per 1000 square feet. Scatter bait evenly over the areas to be treated. Use a suitable mechanical spreader and applications in late afternoon when it is not likely to rain.

NOTE: Mole Crickets are most active at night, especially after a rain or irrigation and when the temperature is above 70°F. When conditions such as these exist, the mole cricket will come to the surface and make burrows in the upper inch or two of soil. It is during this period that they emerge and gather bits of food (bait) from the soil surface.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

Pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

Dispose of container in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers, or bury in a safe place.

Consult Federal, State or Local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures such as limited open burning.
