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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use as a spot application only in places where insects have been observed.

Do not use in the edible products areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.

ROACHES, ANTS, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, CRICKETS: Spray in cracks, around baseboards and other places where these insects hide. Also spray surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, drinking fountains, refrigerators, sinks and stoves. Do not contaminate drinking water. Use on other localized areas infested with these pests. Repeat treatment as required.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, WASPS, AND FLYING MOTHS OUTDOORS: For outdoor use only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, or wherever these insects may enter the room. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures on porches, receiving platforms, in garages, and other places where these insects alight or congregate.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage-Avoid storage at high temperatures. Protect from moisture. Avoid contamination with water, acids or alkalies. Do not store near heat or open flame. Keep container closed. Store in original containers only. Separate pesticides to avoid cross-contamination of other pesticides, fertilizer, food and feed. Keep container in locked storage areas.

If spilled, absorb with dry materials such as sand and sawdust and sweep up for disposal.
