DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **ROACHES and WATERBUGS** are controlled by closing windows and doors and filling area with fog, after directing spray under sinks, refrigerators, in washrooms, under tables and shelving, toward baseboards and moldings and around pipe openings in walls, etc. Do not remain in treated areas. After twenty minutes the area should be ventilated and the fallen insects swept up and destroyed. Repeat treatment as often as necessary.

The accessible stages of **GRANARY WEEVILS, RICE WEEVILS, CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLES, SAWTOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES, SPIDER BEETLES, CIGARETTE BEETLES, DRUGSTORE BEETLES, ANGOUMOIS GRAIN MOTHS, MEDITERRANEAN FLOUR MOTHS, INDIAN MEAL MOTHS, and TOBACCO MOTHS** are controlled in stored product areas by closing doors and windows and directing toward walls, cross beams, under pallets, over and around stacked goods, into emptied bins, directing spray into corners, etc., to get thorough coverage of all surfaces. More frequent applications, at least weekly, should be made during hot weather. Dispose of all infested products.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children. Do not spray on or near an open flame. Avoid contamination of feed and footstuffs. Prior to spraying remove children and pets from area to be treated. Cover fish bowls and tanks. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Use in food processing plants only when plant is not in operation. Food should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered or thoroughly cleaned before using.

Physical & Chemical Hazards

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Storage: Store at ambient temperatures and do not over-heat. If spilled, absorb spill with sand, sawdust or dirt. Contain spill by diking to keep out of sewers. Store in original containers only. Separate pesticides to prevent cross-contamination of other pesticides, fertilizers, food and feed.

Disposal: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticides wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of federal law. Container Disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
