FOR CONTROL OF ROACHES, WATERBUGS, AND SILVERFISH: Add 1 pint of 43% Malathion Emulsifiable Concentrate to 2 gallons of water to make a 3% emulsion. Mix thoroughly and apply as a wet spray. Thorough and repeated spraying of the infested area, directing the spray into cracks and other hiding places is recommended. For best results, insects should be hit directly.

FOR CONTROL OF ANTS: Add 1 pint of 45% Malathion Emulsifiable Concentrate to 2 gallons of water to make a 3% emulsion. Mix thoroughly and apply as a wet spray, especially to ant trails and areas around door sills and window frames where the pests enter the premises. Repeated applications are required.

FOR CONTROL OF FLEAS: Add 1 pint of 45% Malathion Emulsifiable Concentrate to 2 gallons of water to make a 3% emulsion. Mix thoroughly and apply as a wet spray, placing emphasis on treatment of floors, baseboards, floor covering, and wall cracks, as well as sleeping quarters of animals. Animal quarters should not be treated more frequently than once every two or three weeks.

FOR CONTROL OF BEDBUGS: Add 1 pint to 6 gallons of water to make a 1% emulsion. Apply the emulsion lightly to all mattress surfaces in sufficient quantity to "mist" the fabric. Apply generously to beams and woodwork, with special care taken to wet all possible hiding places. Repeat as necessary.

CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of the eyes and repeated or prolonged skin contact. Avoid prolonged breathing of spray mist. Avoid contamination of foodstuffs, cooking utensils, dishes and work surfaces used in the preparation of foods. Wash thoroughly after using.
