

if your toxicological data suggest otherwise, please submit a draft Statement of Practical Treatment for prior approval:

If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with a finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If on skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

If in eyes - Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

Note to Physician: Diazinon is an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine.

The EPA Registration Number/Establishment Number and the company name (please include a street address/P.O. Box) and city/State should be located at the bottom of the front label.

- c. Add the statement, "Recommended for Commercial/Industrial Use Only" or "Only For Sale To, Use and Storage by Pest Control Operators" to the front panel.
- d. Revise the fifth sentence of the Precautionary Statement section to read, "Wash with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, or using tobacco products."
- e. Under the Environmental Hazards section delete "Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds." In its place add, "Do not apply directly to water."

f. Revise the "Pesticide Disposal" statement to read:

Waste resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

3. We note that you had not submitted a 1-year storage stability study. From the date of this registration you will be allowed 15 months to provide this study to the Agency in support of your product.

4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

GENERAL TREATMENT: Apply a small amount of the product directly to localized areas where cockroaches are found or normally occur, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls, along and behind baseboards; beneath and behind sinks and cabinets, around plumbing and other utility installations. Do not allow dust to contact food, feedstuffs or water supplies. Thoroughly wash dishes and food handling utensils with soap and water if they become contaminated by application of this product.

FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS: Places other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared or served.

FOOD AREAS: Includes areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing), preparing, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups). Serving areas (when food is exposed and facility is in operation) would also be considered a food area. Application limited to Crack and Crevice treatment only.

Apply a small amount directly into cracks and crevices using a bulbous duster in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where cockroaches may hide.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

ESTABLISHMENTS, OTHER THAN CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ARE NOT PERMITTED.
