HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Pesticide Storage

Keep out of reach of children and animals. Store in original container only in a cool, dry place to avoid excess heat. Carefully open containers in case of spill. Avoid contact, isolate area and keep out of animal and unprotected persons. Confine spills.

Pesticide Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

Container Disposal

Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

HOW TO USE

To control chinch bugs, sod webworms, ants, armyworms, crickets, cut worms, earwigs, and sowbugs, uniformly apply 2.4 pounds of this product to cover 1,000 square feet of non-crop turfgrass area. Treat when insects first appear; re-treat as needed. To help obtain uniform distribution, apply one-half the required amount of product in one direction, then apply balance at a right angle. Immediately after application, thoroughly water the treated turf to wash the insecticide into the zone of insect infestation.
