

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

- 1) In Reg. No. 6720-466, the proposed labeling statement, "This product does not contain Chlorofluorocarbons", is acceptable provided that the following statement is added: "Federal Regulations prohibit CFCs in aerosols".
- 2) With regard to Reg. No. 6720-474, you should add the following statement to the Directions for Use involving hospitals: "After spraying, ventilate areas for two (2) hours before returning patients."
- 3) If desired, you may delete the statement, "Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters", since it doesn't apply to the use of these products.
