DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Application should be made only by experienced personnel using approved safety equipment. Apply when air is calm, in the greatest amount of spray. Make thorough coverage of plants with uniform deposit of spray. Treat at the first sign of infestation and repeat at regular intervals when needed to maintain control, but observe use limits on each specific crop.

OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING USE PRECAUTIONS

- This product is toxic to wildlife. Birds feeding on the treated insects are killed. Apply this product only as directed on the label.
- This product is highly toxic to fish. Do not apply to water bodies or on crops. Protective measures should be taken to prevent contamination of water. Agricultural Extension Service.

RECOMMENDATIONS

COTTON

For control of cotton bollworm, tobacco budworm, and other insects on cotton.

Apply 15 to 25 lbs. of 2.5-10 Methyl Parathion-Seven per acre, broadcast or in rows.

For control of Mexican cotton bollworm, apply 15 to 25 lbs. of 2.5-10 Methyl Parathion-Seven per acre, broadcast or in rows.

Apply 15 to 25 lbs. of 2.5-10 Methyl Parathion-Seven per acre, broadcast or in rows.

For control of Pink Bollworm, apply 15 to 25 lbs. of 2.5-10 Methyl Parathion-Seven per acre, broadcast or in rows.

Apply 15 to 25 lbs. of 2.5-10 Methyl Parathion-Seven per acre, broadcast or in rows.

- **POISONING SYMPTOMS:** Headache, blurred vision, weakness, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, and discomfort in chest.
- **ANTIDOTE:** Atropine is the specific antidote. Obtain emergency supply of atropine 1-100 mg. tablets from your physician. Keep on hand.

FIRST AID TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Give tablespoon of salt in a glass of warm water. Repeat until vomit flows freely. Have victim lie down and keep quiet.

INHALATION: Remove patient from contaminated atmosphere.

SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and immediately wash contaminated area with soap and water.

EYES: Flush eyes with water immediately with water for at least 15 minutes.

- **IF SWALLOWED:** Give atropine. Give atropine preferably by mouth, 2 to 4 mg. at once and every hour as needed until the patient obtains full atropine reaction. 2-PAM is the antidote for atropine poisoning. Administer 2-PAM in conjunction with atropine. Never give atropine to a patient with atropine poisoning. Artificial respiration may be necessary if patient is unconscious. Administer atropine until patient is conscious.
