If water not immediately available, remove cover, shower with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. If not available, use any other liquid to wash. Call a physician.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Handling Precautions

DO NOT INHALE VAPORS: NIOSH- or MESA-approved respiratory protection should be worn when TELONE II liquid and fumigant is applied to the atmosphere or when conducting operations which vent to the atmosphere. A NIOSH- or MESA-approved half-face respirator with chemical filter or full-face respirator shall be used during small spills, in enclosed structures, and when working in poorly ventilated areas. When in use, cartridges or canisters shall be replaced daily or as indicated by manufacturer or at first sign of odor breakthrough, whichever comes first. NIOSH-approved cartridges, such as a Wash 1000-II, will be adequate for short-term situations such as listed above.

Where very high concentrations of vapors might be expected (such as large spills in poorly ventilated areas) a self-contained or air-supplied respirator should be used.

DO NOT GET ON SKIN: When handling or working with TELONE II, wear clean body covering including gloves and heavy footwear. Immediately remove contaminated covering. Avoid and wash all protective clothing and gear thoroughly after use.

There are no short-term protection and shall be immediately decontaminated upon contamination. Heavy (1 - mil) polyethylene, rubber, neoprene, butyl, or other inert plastic material should be worn. If gear becomes contaminated immediately wash with soap and water. Never wear protective gear having odor of TELONE II. Wash and avoid all protective gear thoroughly after use until all odor is gone.

DO NOT GET IN EYES: Wear eye protection such as chemical goggles or full-face respirator when handling TELONE II.

DO NOT SWALLOW: Do not use the mouth to siphon TELONE II from containers or to blow out clogged hose, nozzle, etc.

RE-ENTRY

Certain crops including cereals, legumes, and melons are tolerant to ammonia and the above rate does not apply to them. When using high rates of TELONE II as required by certain state survey regulations, rates of 100% will apply before fumigation may terminate nitrogen and reduce the possibility of ammonia toxicity. Certain nursery crops such as citrus seedlings, Citrus sp., apricot, and vegetable crops such as cauliflower have shown evidence of phytotoxicity following fumigation. To avoid this possible effect, it is suggested that additional precautions be used on soils where experience indicates a deficiency may occur.

Ammonia: To avoid phytotoxicity of treated soil do not use irrigation water, transplants, seeds, plants, or crop remains that could carry ammonia from one treatment to another. Consult your local extension service for more information.
