

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER

Keep Out Of Reach Of Children
Poisonous If Swallowed, Inhaled Or
Absorbed Through Skin
May Be Injurious To Eyes And Skin

Do not wear contaminated clothing. Do not breathe vapor or spray mist. Handle concentrate in ventilated area. Keep away from food, feedstuffs and water supplies. Do not get on skin or in eyes. Wear natural rubber gloves, waterproof protective clothing and goggles when handling the concentrate to prepare emulsions. Wear a pesticide respirator jointly approved by the Mining Enforcement and Safety Administration (formerly the U. S. Bureau of Mines) and by the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health under the provisions of 30 CFR Part II. Keep all unprotected persons out of operational area. Do not allow children to contact treated areas until spray has dried.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, wildlife and birds. Keep out of any body of water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Combustible. Keep container closed. Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flame.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

ORKINBAN PLUS Concentrate is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine is an antidote. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine. Call a physician in all cases of suspected poisoning.

Morphine is contraindicated. Clear chest by postural drainage. Observe patient closely for 48 hours.

Repeated exposure to cholinesterase inhibitors may without warning, cause prolonged susceptibility to very small doses of any cholinesterase inhibitor.

Allow no further exposure until time for cholinesterase regeneration has been allowed as determined by blood test.

Start artificial respiration immediately if breathing has stopped.

SYM TOMS:

Symptoms include weakness, headache, tightness in chest, blurred vision, non-reactive pin point pupils, salivation, sweating, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal cramps.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage Combustible. Keep container closed. Do not store near heat or open flame. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide disposal Pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to Federal, State or local procedures under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.

Container disposal Triple rinse or equivalent and offer for recycling or reconditioning, or dispose of in a sanitary land fill, or by other approved State and local procedures.

ORKINBAN PLUS Concentrate mixes readily amount in water or in a base oil, such as:

FOR INSECTICIDE SPRAY—containing 0.5% Mix 4 oz. ORKINBAN PLUS Concentrate per

FOR SPRAY—containing 0.25% chlorpyrifos. 2 oz. ORKINBAN PLUS Concentrate per gal

Use the higher concentration to quickly reduce concentration on light infestations.

ORKINBAN PLUS Concentrate controls bed roaches, ants, crickets, firebrats, silverfish and commercial buildings, including home houses and similar structures.

Use as a spot treatment by applying as a crevice areas where the above mentioned pests nor dark corners of rooms and closets, at the behind base boards, behind and beneath sink and around drain pipes. Apply in a manner feedstuffs and water supplies. Dishes and thoroughly washed in soap and water if they application of this product. Repeat treatment trails, also around doors and windows and entrance.

For control of Brown Dog Ticks thoroughly treatment to infested areas such as pet bed and crevices; along and behind baseboards, infested areas of floor and floor covering where bedding of pets should be removed and re-treatment.

Flies and Mosquitoes: Use only out of door from these insects. Thoroughly apply concentrate window and door frames as well as other a crevice into structures. Also spray dark corners (as under eaves) where flies and mosquitoes when effectiveness diminishes.

APPLICATIONS WITHIN FOOD AREAS OF limited to Crack and Crevice Treatment Only by means of a low pressure spray and spray into cracks and crevices such as expansion construction or between equipment bases and ment legs where cockroaches, crickets, firebrat Care should be taken to avoid depositing concentrate introducing the material into the air. Avoid contact with surfaces.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

- If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. If possible, vomiting should be induced under medical supervision. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
- If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.
- If on skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.
- If in eyes - Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

STORAGE: If container is damaged: Stop any leaks by repositioning the container or by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks.
