20% Chlordane Solution in Oil

ACTIVE INGREDIENT

20% Chlordane
80% Petroleum Solvent

For use in the manufacture of pesticides by professional Pest Control Operators. Dilute with 9 volume of solvent. Use oil to obtain a spot treatment for furniture and roach. Apply in a coarse wet stream of paint on baseboards, behind cabinet, around door, or wherever roaches are seen entering or leaving the room.

For Control of Powder Post Beetles: Dilute 1 part concentrate with 9 parts Kero-sene or kerosene solvent. Apply by spraying or painting directly on infested wood. A compressed air type sprayer is satisfactory and best penetration is obtained if the nozzle is held about 4 inches from the surface being treated. A brush should be used to treat small areas next to paint or wallpaper. It is important that the spraying be done thoroughly and that all surfaces being treated are completely wet.

CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Do not use on painted material. When diluted, use as a spot treatment only. Do not use on bare plaster or in an area wide treatment. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get on face, eyes, or in mouth. Avoid breathing spray mist. In case of contact with skin, wash with soap and water. Avoid contamination of feed and food stuff.

To protect birds, fish, and wildlife. Keep out of any body of water.

Contactible mixture. Do not use near open flame or pilot light.

Do not use in edible product area of food processing plant, restaurant, or other area where food is commonly prepared or processed. Do not use in drying area where food is exposed.

Do not reuse container. Destroy when empty. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of waste.
