QUIXIDE quickly kills many flying and crawling insects found in schools, hospitals, cafeterias, storage areas and food plants when used as directed. For Flying Insects: Flies, Mosquitoes, Flying Moths, Gnats, Wasp. There is no need to spray directly at flying insects - the mist in the air will kill them. Close all the doors and windows. Spray or fog up into the air with a sweeping motion, keeping about 3ft. from interior wall, fabrics, furniture and plants. Keep room closed for 15 minutes. For Crawling Insects: Roaches, Waterbugs, Silverfish, Crickets, Spray hiding places such as baseboards and floor boards, moist places, opening around sinks, drains and pipes, behind bookcases, cabinets, and other storage areas, hitting as many bugs as possible.

ANTS: Spray trails, hills, around window sills and opening around pipes and baseboards where ants crawl, hitting as many as possible.

SPIDERS, CENTIPEDES, SOA BUGS: Spray webs and the places where these pest crawl.

CARPET BEETLES: Hit these bugs directly with spray on sections of the floor, baseboard, shelves and carpets.

BED BUGS: Spray baseboard moldings, floor boards. Spray mattresses, particularly around seams and tuftd. Take bed apart and spray into all joints.

FLEAS: Spray floors, floor openings and sleeping quarters for pets. Replace your pet's bedding with fresh bedding after treatment.
