

Microban W.B. Spray, Formula X-580 for Empty Garbage Containers should be applied with hand-operated or continuous pressure-type sprayers, either manual or powered, to empty garbage containers where disease-causing bacteria and mold and mildew causing fungus spores usually thrive.

Clean empty garbage container surface first for disinfection or mold protection. Spray these areas until moist, giving special attention to cracks and crevices. Allow ten to twenty minutes for drying. It is not necessary to wipe the sprayed garbage container surface, as the diluents in Microban W.B. Spray provide rapid drying effectiveness. Repeat weekly or as necessary to maintain control.

For control of exposed stages of roaches, thoroughly spray all areas of empty garbage containers harboring them. Special attention should be paid to cracks and hidden surfaces of the empty garbage containers. Thorough and repeated treatments which contact the insect directly are necessary for control.

Microban Sprays are also active in the control of mold and mildew-causing fungi on empty garbage container surfaces and against odors resulting from bacteria and fungi organisms.

Microban W.B. Spray, Formula X-580 for Empty Garbage Containers will not damage metal and plastic garbage container surfaces, when applied as directed. It dries rapidly and leaves the treated empty garbage container surfaces with a bacteriostatic and fungistatic residual coating against many bacteria and fungi.
