Microban is a bactericide against  
most gram positive germs such as  
Staphylococcus aureus and a bac-  
tericide against many gram nega-  
tive Bacteria. Microban spray  
should be applied to clean sur-  
faces if disinfection is desired.

Microban is active in the con-  
trol of mold and mildew-causing  
fungi and against odors resulting  
from bacteria and fungi organ-  
isms. For mildew control, clean  
all surfaces (walls, floors, and  
hard surfaces) before applica-  
tions. Spray until moist. For effec-  
tive control repeat application  
weekly or as necessary to main-  
tain control.

Microban aerosol spray is non-  
staining. It dries instantly. It will  
not damage metal, tile surfaces,  
painted walls, and furniture.

## WARNING:

Contents under pressure. Do not  
puncture. Do not use or store  
near heat or open flame. Expo-  
sure to temperatures above 130°  
Fahrenheit may cause bursting.  
Never throw container into fire or  
incinerator. Avoid food contami-
