INSECTICIDE DIRECTIONS

A spray for roaches, ants, crickets, silverfish, fleas and bedbugs and space spray for flies, mosquitoes and gnats.

DIRECTIONS

For a surface spray of roaches and certain other crawling insects, apply at the rate of 1 gallon per 1000 square feet.

The extent and duration of the killing power will vary according to the types of surfaces, temperatures, and humidity and other local conditions.

Spraying for Crawling Insects: Discharge spray liberally, applying spray directly on as many insects as possible. Repeat applications as often as necessary to maintain control.

Cockroaches: Apply as a surface spray or discharge spray liberally directly into hiding places. Spray liberally and directly into all cracks, crevices, dark corners, under counters, into recesses, closets, baseboards, or other hiding places. When roaches become excited and leave hiding places, apply spray directly on as many as possible. While they will be killed by the deposit of spray, death will ensue much faster if insects are hit directly.

Ants: Treat same as for roaches, giving special attention to the treatment of ant trails, and areas around door sills and window frames where pests enter premises.

Fleas: Areas infested with adult fleas should be treated by discharging spray at the rate of 1 gallon per 1000 square feet on floors and into cracks and crevices in rooms where animals are kept. Spray bedding and infested rugs; repeat applications as necessary to insure against their recurrence. Do not apply directly to animals.

Silverfish: Treat cracks, crevices, bookshelves, paper storage, or other hiding places.

Crickets: Treat behind radiators, fireplaces, cracks, and crevices in basement.

Bedbugs: To control bedbugs effectively, apply liberally to top, ends, sides and bottom of mattresses, spraying thoroughly all tufts, seams, and folds. Spray springs and frame, directing the liquid into all cracks and lock joints. Treat walls, baseboards, moldings, floors, closets and bedroom furniture, picture frames, with particular attention to protected bedbug hiding and breeding places.

Ants: Treat same as for roaches, giving special attention to the treatment of trails, and to the treatment of door sills and window frames where pests enter outside

Flies: Apply as a space spray liberally in the room to be treated. Apply at the rate of 1 gallon per 1000 square feet. This spray is not intended for use on food, clothing, or animals. Keep spray bottle and container tightly closed. Repeat applications as often as necessary to maintain control. Do not apply directly to animals.

Crickets: Apply as a surface spray or discharge spray liberally directly on the insects. Repeat applications as often as necessary to maintain control.

Fleas and Bedbugs: Apply as a surface spray or discharge spray liberally directly on the insects. Repeat applications as often as necessary to maintain control. For fleas, apply to the animal's bedding and the animal's environment. For bedbugs, apply to the bed and surrounding areas.
