

CLEANS - Disinfects - Deodorizes

— Directions for Use —

GENERAL DISINFECTING AND DEODORIZING:

Use four ounces per gallon of water. Scrub surface and allow to stand a few minutes and rinse off.

LIGHT CLEANING OF FLOORS, WALLS, WOODWORK:

Use four ounces per 3 gallons of water. After surface has been cleaned, rinse again with an identical solution. Allow to stand a few minutes and then pick up and dry surface.

TO COMBAT MOLD AND FUNGI:

~~Wipe or mop down area with solution of 4 ounces per gallon of water. Do not rinse, but allow surface to dry. This solution is usually effective on clothes, shower stalls, walls or most any surface where mold occurs.~~

TOILETS AND URINALS:

Pour in a solution equal to 3 ounces per gallon of water. Scrub clean and allow to stand until unit is flushed. Wipe down seat with fresh solution and allow to dry.

BARBER AND BEAUTY SHOP EQUIPMENT

Clean thoroughly and then soak combs, brushes, razors, etc. for 10 minutes in a clean solution of 4 ounces per gallon of water.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, flush with plenty of water. For eyes, get medical attention immediately. Rinse empty container before discarding.
