GENERAL DEODORIZING AND DISINFECTING

When diluted at the rate of 1:80 this solution shows disinfectant activity against surfaces contaminated with dried films of tubercle bacilli in organic matter. For general deodorizing and disinfecting use 4 oz. per gallon of water and scrub surfaces and allow to stand a few minutes and rinse off.

GENERAL DISINFECTING OF BATHROOMS, Etc. Use 4 to 5 ounces per gallon of water and scrub surface, allowing to remain a few minutes and rinse off.

BARBER SHOP AND BEAUTY PARLOR EQUIPMENT: Clean thoroughly, then soak combs, brushes, razors, etc., or 10 mins. in a solution of 4 oz. per gallon of water.

Use a solution of 3 to 4 oz. per gallon of water. Allow to dry. Works on cloth, or any surface where mold or scum is observed that a water solution will not remove.
