The bowl cleaner removes stains and encrustations from vitreous toilet bowls and urinals while cleaning the trap or invisible outlet. Application is simple and clean. Note: The bowl cleaner should be used only on vitreous toilets and urinals; use on any other surface is at user's risk.

ANTIDOTE:

INTERNAL — Call a physician immediately. Drink a teaspoonful or more of magnesia, chalk, or small pieces of soap, softened with water in milk or raw egg white.

EXTERNAL — Eyes. Wash with water for 15 minutes. Get prompt medical attention. Skin — Wipe off acid gently, immediately flood the surface with water, using soap freely, then cover with moist magnesia or baking soda.

DIRECTIONS

To clean toilet bowls and urinals: Force water from the bowl with small bowl mop. Pour cleaner on bowl mop or brush held over bowl. Rub bowl and under the rim to remove discolorations. For severe discoloration, repeat and allow solution to remain 15 minutes before flushing.

To clean invisible trap or outlet: Remove drain plate and place bowl mop in the drain. Pour ½ pint of fluid on the mop, allowing it to remain 2 or 3 minutes until reaction is completed, then work mop up and down until scale is removed. Flush.

NOTE: Before discarding this container, rinse thoroughly with water.
