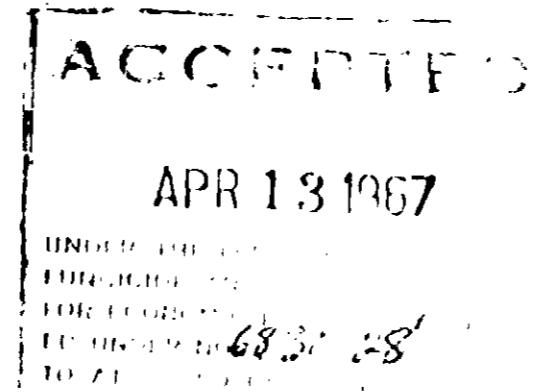

(C₁₄, 50%; C₁₂, 40%; C₁₆, 10%)

Inert Ingredients: 95.0%

RECOMMENDED DILUTION RATIOS FOR CHASE: (per gallon of water)

Painted Walls:	2 ozs.
Floors:	3-4 ozs.
Tiled Areas:	2-4 ozs.

To apply simply wash or scrub with CHASE. Rinse off ... the result is a clean and sanitary area.

CHASE is safe on asphalt tile, wood, terrazzo, linoleum, etc. It will not harm painted surfaces.

CHASE used as a maintenance cleaner results in less frequent cleaning.

CHASE may be used for all types of general maintenance work. It is especially effective in removing oil and grease from walls, floors, sanitary equipment, etc.

CHASE may be added to washing machines at the rate of 1 oz. per gallon of water for sanitizing clothes, wiping rags and safety equipment.

DEODORIZING ACTION:

Due to the effective action of CHASE during the cleaning operation, odor and mold formation is inhibited.

CHASE has a pleasant, clean odor, and unlike many other sanitizers, does not contain pine oil and coal tars which temporarily mask odors with their own heavy smells.

CHASE maintains its cleaning ability even in the hardest water, hot or cold. CHASE is freely rinsable and leaves no film.
