- Correct the Container Disposal statement



Lonza is submitting an application to make two restorations to the 6836-24 label. First, the signal word below the KOROC statement was not visible on the 4-6-10 stamped label. The text color has been corrected, and DANGER is now visible. The second correction is to the Container Disposal statement. Language inappropriate for this manufacturing use product was added to this section. The triple rinse and recycling statements from the 8-22-03 stamped label have been restored on the proposed label.

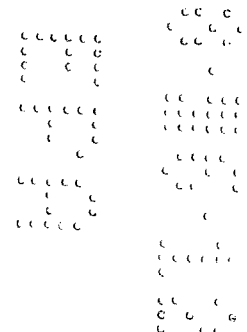
