The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable with the following conditions listed below:

Update the first Aid Statements, Precautionary Statements and Storage and Disposal Statements

**CONDITIONS**

1. The Agency has completed risk assessments to characterize the chemical, Didecyl Dimethyl Ammonium Chloride (DDAC). During this process, the acute toxicology profile was determined for Manufacturing Use Products (MUP) with an active ingredient concentration ranging from 40% to 80%. According to this data, this product is classified as follows:

Primary Eye	Tox I
Primary Skin	Tox I
Acute Inhalation	Tox II
Acute Dermal	Tox III
Acute Oral	Tox II

Thus revise the Precautionary Statements to read exactly as follows:

Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield, protective clothing and rubber gloves. May be fatal if swallowed or inhaled. Do not breathe spray mist (or vapor). Wear a dust mist filtering respirator (MSHA/NIOSH approval number preferred). Harmful if absorbed through the skin.
