The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

1. Revise the statement "If swallowed, immediately give 3-4 glasses of milk; if unavailable, give water" to read "If swallowed, promptly drink quantity of egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink quantities of water."
2. The statement "Keep Out of Reach of Children" must be placed immediately above the signal word "DANGER."
3. Revise the first active ingredient to read:

Alkyl (C₁₄ 60%, C₁₂ 25%, C₁₆ 15%)
Dimethyl Benzyl Ammonium Chloride
