The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the following comment.

Proposed Amendment:

- revise labeling per EPA letter dated 8/28/03

Conditions revise label as follows:


1. Per EPA letter dated September 25, 2003, number #5 the statement which follows the product name at the top of the right column is too broad. The Agency is moving toward revising MUP labels to list the specific sites at which a product may be formulated for use, not the pesticidal claims associated with those uses. Revise the statement: "For Formulation into Antimicrobial Products" to read: "For use by manufacturers only in formulation antimicrobial products for the uses indicated on the label.
2. According to the Agency's use site database for this active ingredient, wood preservatives, industrial processes and water systems are not supported. You must either delete these use site or submit an amendment adding it to the label. (Reminder: If you choose to add the use site, you must address data

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER! CORROSIVE. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. May be fatal if inhaled, swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Do not breathe vapor. FIRST AID

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. This product for formulation into antimicrobial products for use in/on Agricultural premises and equipment, Food Handling/storage establishment premises and equipment, Commercial, institutional and industrial premises and equipment, Residential and public access premises, Materials and Preservatives, Medical Premises and equipment, Industrial processes and water systems, Wood preservatives and Swimming Pools. Formulators using this product are responsible for providing data for the EPA registration of their formulated products. This product may be used to formulate products for specific use(s) not listed on this label if the formulator or primary registrant has complied with U.S. EPA data requirements regarding the support of such use(s).

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE

Do not store on side.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law.
