PERSONAL PROTECTION

CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning or
incineration and disposal of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, if it
cannot be done. Do not reuse or refill container by hand. If broken, stay out of
container. Triple rinse (or equivalent), then offer for recycling or reconditioning,
or dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local
authorities. (If container is 1 gallon or less, use this container disposal

container and put in trash.

ACTIVE INGREDIENT

n-Alkyl (50% C₁₂, 40% C₁₄, 10% C₁₆) dimethyl benzyl ammonium chloride 5.0%

INERT INGREDIENTS 95.0%

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician.

IF ON SKIN: Wash thoroughly with soap and water. Remove and wash contaminated
clothing before reuse.

IF SWALLOWED: Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if
these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician
immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures
against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a solution of federal law to use this product in a manner
consistent with the following:

FOR CLEANING

Lightly soiled areas — surfaces to be cleaned should be
mopped or brushed with a solution containing 1 ounce of
per gallon of water. Rinse cleaned
area with fresh water.

Heavily soiled areas — mop or brush soiled surface with a
solution containing 2 ounces of
per gallon of water. Rinse cleaned surface with fresh water.

GENERAL PURPOSE DISINFECTION

To disinfect walls, floors and other hard non-porous surfaces of
homes, schools, restaurants, taverns and other public areas,
mop or brush with a fresh solution containing 1 ounce of
per gallon of water so as to maintain
thoroughly soiled surface for five minutes. All soiled surfaces
must be pre-cleaned prior to disinfection (follow directions for
cleaning). These surfaces which may later come in contact with
food must be rinsed with clear water of drinking quality. Do not
reuse used solution.

To disinfect hard-surface surfaces in kitchen rooms, shower
stalls, bathroom animal pens and other areas (avoid gallo-
phobic floor), mop or brush with a fresh solution containing 1
ounce of
per gallon of water so as to
maintain thoroughly soiled surface for five minutes. This
solution will destroy *Staphylococcus aureus*, a common
agent of skin's heat. All soiled surfaces must be pre-cleaned
prior to disinfection (follow directions for cleaning). Do not
reuse used solution.

To disinfect toilet bowls, flush toilet (has had the bowl water
over the top), flush directly to bowl water 2 ounces of
solution. Flush and scrub thoroughly (scrubbing
under the rim, and allow to remain wet for at least ten minutes
before flushing bowl).

HOSPITAL DISINFECTION

To disinfect walls, floors, furniture and other hard non-porous
surfaces in hospitals and nursing homes, mop or brush with a
fresh solution containing 2 ounces of
per gallon of water so as to maintain thoroughly soiled surface
for five minutes. All soiled surfaces must be pre-cleaned prior to
disinfection (follow directions for cleaning). These surfaces that
are heavily soiled with blood, fecal matter or pus should be
thoroughly scrubbed with a solution containing 2 ounces of
per gallon of water, and then rinsed
with a fresh solution containing 2 ounces of
per gallon of water before disinfection. Do not reuse
used solution. This product has not been tested for effectiveness
against *Mycobacterium tuberculosis* and must not be relied
upon when tuberculous activity is suspected by the user.

DEODORIZATION

Prior to disinfection of bathroom areas, garbage pails, diaper
pails, lead storage areas, kennel areas and other areas where
obnoxious odors may develop, remove all garbage, refuse, food
and/or animal. Pre-clean surfaces using pressurized water
where possible before deodorization. To deodorize, mop or
brush surfaces thoroughly with a solution containing 2 ounces of
per gallon of water.

SANITIZATION

To sanitize walls, floors and other hard non-porous, non-lead
contact surfaces in the presence of a moderate amount of
organic soil, mop or brush with a solution containing 1 ounce of
per gallon of water so as to maintain
thoroughly soiled surface for five minutes. These surfaces that
are heavily soiled must be pre-cleaned prior to sanitization
(follow directions for cleaning)

MOLD AND MILDEW CONTROL

To control mold and mildew on previously cleaned glass, metal,
plastic, tile and other hard non-porous surfaces, mop or brush
with a fresh solution containing 2 ounces of
per gallon of water so as to maintain
thoroughly soiled surface for five minutes. These surfaces that
are heavily soiled must be pre-cleaned prior to mold and mildew
control. Do not reuse used solution.
