1. The signal word "DANGER" must be placed immediately below the child hazard warning statement.
2. Delete the word "milk" from the Statement of Practical Treatment.
3. Group all the Storage and Disposal sections together.
4. Include the word "Combustible" to the "Physical or Chemical Hazards." (Refer to our letter of November 20, 1981, item c.)
5. The words "Active Ingredients" should be singular.
6. The headings "Active Ingredients" and "Inerts Ingredients" must be aligned to the same margin.


