Toxicity Category I for Primary Eye and Primary Skin, Child Resistant Packaging is required as per 40 CFR parts 157.20 through 157.36.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS DANGER: Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO CLEAN, SANITIZE AND DEODORIZE CARPETS:

STEAM EXTRACTION: Vacuum carpet thoroughly. Mix two (2) ounces of LONZA CARPET SANITIZER CS-202 per gallon of water. Inject and extract as you would any steam cleaning shampoo.

EXTRACTION: Vacuum carpet thoroughly. Mix two (2) ounces of LONZA CARPET SANITIZER CS-202 per gallon of water. Prespray onto the carpet at a rate of ½ - ½ gallon per 100 square feet and extract as you would other extract cleaning shampoos.

SPIN BONNET (BONNET BUFF) CLEANING: Vacuum carpet thoroughly. Mix four (4) ounces of LONZA CARPET SANITIZER CS-202 per gallon of water. Bonnet on carpet at rate of 200 - 300 sq. ft. per gallon.

BONNET CLEANING: Vacuum carpet thoroughly. Mix four (4) ounces of **LONZA CARPET SANITIZER CS-202** per gallon of water. Spray on carpet at rate of 200 - 300 sq. ft. per gallon.

HEAVY DUTY SPIN BONNET (BONNET BUFF) CLEANING:

Vacuum carpet thoroughly. Mix sixteen (16) ounces of LONZA CARPET SANITIZER CS-202 per gallon of water. Spray on carpet at rate of 200 - 300 sq. ft. per gallon.

Place aluminum foil under legs of furniture while carpet is drying. Over wetting can cause shrinking of carpet. Manufacturer assumes no responsibility for over wetting or misuse.

HOUSEHOLD: Vacuum carpet thoroughly. Mix two (2) ounces of LONZA CARPET SANITIZER CS-202 per gallon of water. Spray on carpet but do not overwet. Allow to air dry. Place aluminum foil under legs of furniture while carpet is drying. Over wetting can cause shrinking of carpet. When dry, vacuum as usual.

NOTE: Test color fastness of carpet before use. Apply diluted cleaner to a small, concealed spot, and then rub with a clean, white cloth. If color transfers to the cloth or changes, a water base product should not be used.

NOTE Not recommended for use on Stain-Resistant Nylon Carpets. Consult carpet manufacturer's warranty and maintenance instructions for proper use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
