Lonza is submitting a *Notification of Change in the Pesticide Storage Statement*. Lonza is adding the following sentences to that section of the product label.

- Do not store in direct sunlight.
- 2. Do not store at temperatures above 100° F.
- 3. Do not store on side. Avoid creasing or impacting of side walls.

I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 98-10 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
