A stamped copy of the label for each of the subject products is enclosed for your records.



DANGER

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

For eye contact, flush eyes with large amounts of running water for at least 15 minutes. Hold eyelids apart to ensure rinsing of the entire surface of the eye and flush with water. If plastic is not available, flush for additional 15 minutes. Get immediate medical attention.

For skin contact, immediately wipe away excess material with a dry cloth while removing contaminated clothing and shoes. Under a safety shower, wash affected areas thoroughly with large amounts of water, and soap if available, for at least 15 minutes. Get immediate medical attention. Discard or decontaminate clothing and shoes.

If inhaled, remove from area to fresh air. If not breathing, clear airway and start mouth-to-mouth and nasal respiration or use a bag-mask respirator. Get immediate medical attention. If victim is having trouble breathing, transport to medical care and, if available, give supplemental oxygen.
If swallowed, immediately give several glasses of water. Do not induce vomiting. If vomit occurs, give fluid again. Have physician determine if patient's condition allows induction of vomiting or evacuation of stomach. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious or comatose person. Get immediate medical attention. **ACT TO PHYSICIAN.** Probable mucous damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

FOR REFORMULATING AND/OR REPACKAGING USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the labeling.

For use as a disinfectant, algicide, fungicide, bactericide and/or slimeicide for recirculating water systems, antimicrobial for pulp and for manufacture of non-food grades of paper and paperboard, and an enhanced oil recovery in non-estuarine waters.

Reformulated or repackaged products must be registered with EPA. The registrant must supply data required for this registration.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container tightly closed. Store in a dry place. Do not store at elevated temperatures.

DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous and/or toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to the label instructions, contact your State pesticide or environmental control agent or the hazardous waste representative at the nearest EPA regional office for guidance.

METAL AND PLASTIC CONTAINERS: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incinerate or burn, if allowed by State and local authorities. If burned stay out of smoke.

FIBER DRUMS AND LINERS: Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Then dispose of liner and drum in a sanitary landfill or incinerate if allowed by State and local authorities. Do not reuse empty drum or liner.
