

The amendment, referenced above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, to update the first aid statements per PR Notice 2001-1, precautionary statements per Label Manual Chapter 8, and change the product's primary brand name is acceptable provided you address the following comments before you release this product for shipment.

1. Under Precautionary Statements, the fourth sentence must be revised to include "protective clothing" since this product is category I for primary skin irritation.
2. The Agency is currently working on a policy that would require all Manufacturing Use Product (MUP) labels to identify specific end-use scenarios/use sites for which this product may be reformulated to ensure that all generic data requirements have been addressed. This policy will also require that the statement, "For the formulation of disinfectants and sanitizers," be revised to read "For formulation into antimicrobial products."
3. Barquat 80-28RX is acceptable as this product's new primary brand name.

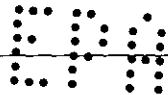
