Dear Mr. Sloan,

The following amendment submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable with the following conditions listed below.

- Update First Aid Statements per PR Notice 2001-1

**Conditions**

Revise the label as follows:

1. The Agency has completed risk assessments to characterize the chemical, Alkyl Dimethyl Ammonium Chloride (ADBAC). During this process, the acute toxicology profile was determined for Manufacturing Use Products (MUP) with an active ingredient concentration ranging from 40% to 80% and End-Use Products (EP) that are formulated repackages of MUPs in the aforementioned concentration range. According to this data, this product is classified as tox. II for acute inhalation, so the "Precautionary Statements" must be revised by adding the following statements:

*May be fatal if inhaled. Do not breathe vapor. Wear a MSHA/NIOSH-approved dust/mist filtering respirator number TC-21C or a NIOSH approved respirator with any N, R, P, or HE filter.*

2. Revise the "First Aid" statements by adding "**If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.**"

3. Under "First Aid," bold the subheadings (If swallowed/If in eyes/If on skin or clothing), so the statements stand out on the label.
