The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, to update the product labeling ingredients statement in accordance with requirements cited in the Reregistration Eligibility Document (RED) for Aliphatic Alcohols, is acceptable.

The Agency has reviewed the submitted labeling and determined that it meets the RED reclassification requirement from active to inert status for a 3% Isopropanol ingredient in a quaternary ammonium compound-based formulation. However, the following labeling changes must be made before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

- Place a colon after "INERT INGREDIENTS" and "TOTAL INGREDIENTS".
- Include the heading "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" followed directly by the Misuse Statement, "It is a violation of Federal Law...". Under the "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" heading, include the statement " For Use Only In Formulation Of Bactericides, Fungicides Or Algicides. Formulators using this product are responsible for obtaining EPA registration for their formulated products."
- The Signal Word "DANGER" should be placed immediately below the Child Hazard Warning.
- After the Signal Word include the heading "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS" followed by the Hazards Statement, "Hazards To Humans And Domestic Animals.".

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- 5. After the sentence "Avoid contamination of food." add the precautionary statement "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.".
- 6. Replace the heading "FIRST AID:" with "STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:".
- 7. Add as the first sentence to the "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS" Section, "This product is toxic to fish.".

It is recommended that you provide an updated Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) for this product. The last CSF of record is dated October 3, 1979, prior to the 1991 transfer of this registration from the Bio-Lab, Inc. product, EPA Registration No. 5185-303, to the present registration now held by Lonza, Inc..

A stamped copy of the BIOQUAT 50-42 product labeling is enclosed for your records. Submit one (1) copy of the revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
