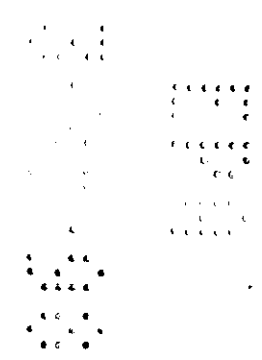

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Directions for Use

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DANTOGARD PLUS INDUSTRIAL PRESERVATIVE preserves and aids in the control of bacteria and fungi in liquid detergents, soft soaps, water-based paints for household and industrial use, room deodorizers and air fresheners, water-based surfactants, polymer emulsions, protective or decorative coatings, water-based gels for household and industrial products, textiles, water-based adhesives, sealants and caulks, latex for paper coatings, and water-based inks.

DANTOGARD PLUS INDUSTRIAL PRESERVATIVE should be added to the formulation to be preserved at a rate of 1.0 to 10.0 lbs. per 1000 lbs. or 0.1% to 1.0% or 1,000 to 10,000 ppm based upon the total weight of the product to be protected.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal. Keep container closed. Store in a dry place. Do not store at elevated temperatures. Keep from freezing.
