




DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DANTOGARD II preserves and aids in the control of bacteria and fungi in liquid detergents, soft soaps, water-based paints for household and industrial use, room deodorizers and air fresheners, water-based surfactants, polymer emulsions, protective or decorative coatings, water-based gels for household and industrial products, textiles, water-based adhesives, latex for paper coatings, and water-based inks.

DANTOGARD II should be added to the formulation to be preserved at a rate of 1.0 to 10.0 lbs. per 1,000 or 0.1% to 1.0% or 1,000 to 10,000 ppm based upon the total weight of the product to be preserved.

NOTE: DANTOGARD II may not be used as a component of articles for use in packaging or holding of food.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep container closed. Store in dry place. Do not store at elevated temperatures. Keep from freezing.

Pesticide Disposal

Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or incineration or if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
