EPA had requested that you submit data to support a food-contact surface use, however, that use has now been removed from the label dated September 28, 1998 and a non-food contact use is specified under the "Directions for Use" statements.

3. Accordingly the statements on the proposed label (EPA Received Date 9/29/98) should be amended as follows:

(a) Under the heading "HAZARDS TO HUMANS"... , the statement, "Avoid contact with eyes or clothing," should be expanded to read, "Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing."

(b) Under the STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT heading, Change the IF IN EYES instructions to read, IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists."

Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

The revised Confidential Statement of Formula dated September 28, 1998 is in compliance with PR Notice 91-2, it agrees with the label claim and is acceptable.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
