

In support of this Notification, enclosed are the following:

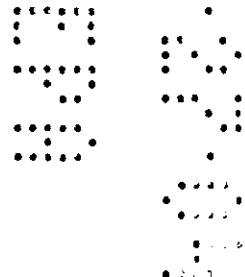

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use GLYCOSERVE II PRESERVATIVE to manufacture products that are used to control bacteria and fungi in liquid detergents, soft soaps, water-based paints for household and Industrial use, room deodorizers and air fresheners, water-based surfactants, polymer emulsions, protective or decorative coatings, water-based gels for household and Industrial products, textiles, water-based inks, and non-food contact water-based adhesives and latex for paper coatings.

Formulators and repackagers of this product must obtain their registrations from the Environmental Protection Agency.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

**Pesticide Storage**
