On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby Registered/Reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act.

A copy of the labeling accepted in connection with this Registration/Reregistration is returned herewith.

In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is unconditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5). Once a pesticide is registered, however, it is not regarded as permanently acceptable. Registration does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. If the Agency determines that, at any time, additional data are required to maintain in effect an existing registration, the Agency will require submission of such data under FIFRA section (3)(c)(2) (B).

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 6836-209" to your label before you release the product for shipment.

b. Modify the statement in the Environmental Hazards paragraph which reads "This pesticide is toxic to fish" to read as follows: "This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates".

2. It should be understood that additional information on the chronic/oncogenicity study in the rat will be required for Bardac 2180 prior to the approval of any subsequent end-uses resulting in the potential for high exposure (e.g., swimming pool algaecides).
