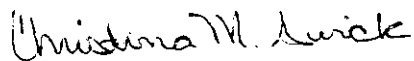

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SWIMMING POOLS AND OUTDOOR SPAS

Lonza Barquat 1552-10% should be added along pool edges while filter and pump are in operation. To provide time for even distribution in the pool water, bathers should wait a minimum of 15 minutes after Lonza Barquat 1552-10% addition before entering the pool.

For pools and spas with visible algae, add 128 fluid ounces (1 gallon) of Lonza Barquat 1552-10% for every 50,000 gallons of water (2 ppm active quaternary). After 24 hours, remove dead algae by cleaning. If algae is still present, repeat dosage as necessary.

For initial treatment of clean pools and spas, add 26 fluid ounces of Lonza Barquat 1552-10% for every 10,000 gallons of water (2 ppm active quaternary). Maintenance additions of 6 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons (0.5 ppm active quaternary) should be added every 7 days, or more frequently depending on water and use factors.

FOR WINTERIZATION

1. Lonza Barquat 1552-10% aids in the prevention of algae in swimming pools during the winter months, when the pool is out of service.
2. Test water for hardness, alkalinity, pH and the presence of metals. Take corrective action if necessary.
3. Superchlorinate the pool using a recommended winter shock treatment according to label directions.
4. Apply Lonza Barquat 1552-10% directly to pool water, pouring along the edges of the pool. Use 128 fluid ounces (1 gallon) per 50,000 gallons of water (2 ppm active quaternary) and allow to circulate 2 to 4 hours. Pools without covers may need a second treatment in mid-winter or just prior to freezing.
5. Clean pool piping and filter. In geographical areas that experience freezing, drain pool equipment and plumbing lines, or use an antifreeze recommended for swimming pool plumbing and equipment.

(Note to reviewer: If container is one gallon or less, the following Storage and Disposal statements will be used:)

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in original container in areas inaccessible to children. Do not store on side. Avoid creasing or impacting of side walls. Do not reuse empty container. Discard in trash or recycle.

(Note to reviewer: If container is greater than one gallon, the following Storage and Disposal statements will be used:)

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store at ambient temperatures. Do not store on side. Avoid creasing or impacting of side walls. Keep container closed when not in use. Leaking or damaged containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. Mop up spills with clean water. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and away from food and feed.
