SWIMMING POOLS AND SPAS

Lonza Barquat 1552-50% should be added along pool edges while filter and pump are in operation. To provide time for even distribution in the pool water, bathers should wait a minimum of 15 minutes after Lonza Barquat 1552-50% addition before entering the pool.
