Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

- Revise the Precautionary Statements by revising the statement "To protect eyes wear goggles or face shield, and to protect skin, wear rubber gloves when handling." to 1. read "Wear protective eyewear (goggles, face shield, or safety glasses), protective clothing, and rubber gloves when handling."
- Revise the Container Disposal section to read:

Container Disposal:

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

PECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER. CORROSIVE: Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing.
